### GENERAL INFORMATION

## THE FACILITIES

The Midwest Bible Campout will again be held at Discovery Ministries, a campground near Eminence, MO. Every person who plans to attend the campout *must* provide his own food and lodging. For those who camp, there are hookups in the campground for mobile homes, campers, and tents. There are public restrooms with showers, so bring your towels with you. Bagged ice and a laundromat are available on the premises.

### Pricing Details

- There is a *maximum* charge for 4 people per immediate family (parents and children).
- This is a *minimum* charge of 3 people/night in a lodge room or cabin.
- There is a *minimum* charge of 4 nights in a lodge room or cabin.
- The listed rates are 25% off the regular rates and are only available Monday through Friday.
