Campground Reservations & Registration

Campground **Reservation** and **Registration** forms are available on the Discovery Ministries Midwest Bible Campout page. Visit https://www.dmchallenge.org/midwest-bible-campout.html or find the link on the Prince Road congregation website. The **Campground Reservation** form is used to reserve a site for a camper. The **Registration** form is for all campers and day visitors. Campers that reserve a site are already registered and do not need to fill out the registration form.

Campsite **reservations** are full for 2024 but you can add your name to the waitlist by filling out the reservation form or by calling Discovery Ministries.

The **Registration** form is open now and will remain open through the end of the campout. One member of each group or family unit should fill out the form, which includes information about what type of accommodations you are expecting to be using, number of people in the party, dates of stay, and the liability waiver. All campers and day visitors should fill out the Registration form. Campers that reserve a site are already registered and do not need to fill out the registration form.


